John Cullinane is the principal in the firm of John Cullinane Associates, a full-service architectural firm specializing in historic preservation. He has been engaged in private architectural practice since 1966, designing structures and projects throughout the country, ranging from individual rehabilitation projects to multi-resource masterplans. He works with federal agencies and private industry to develop techniques for retrofitting historic building systems; create historic preservation plans for federal installations, hydroelectric facilities, and local historic districts; create integrated administrative and resource maintenance training programs; and develop life-cycle cost analysis programs for long-term maintenance planning.

From 1976, he served for 16 years as senior architect for the President's Advisory Council on Historic Preservation. Responsibilities included planning and design consultations with federal agencies, cities, state governments, and private developers on federally assisted projects affecting significant properties and seeking solutions to economic, social, cultural, and architectural issues on specific projects or broad programs.
