Jean Carroon is a principal with Goody Clancy & Associates, a Boston-based architecture and planning firm. She is a LEED-Accredited Professional, responsible for the design and implementation of high-performance projects for institutional clients such as Harvard University, Yale University, the National Park Service, and the General Services Administration. Her work is focused on the renovation of significant National Landmark structures such as the Massachusetts State House and H. H. Richardson's Trinity Church in the City of Boston. The renovation of Trinity Church includes the development of 15,000 square feet of raw space below the church and the installation of six geothermal wells for a heat-pump system.
