Installation cultural resources managers will be responsible for consultation with the State Historic Preservation Offices (SHPOs) and/or Tribal Historic Preservation Offices (THPOs) regarding the Section 110 surveys results.

Installations may supplement Legacy Program funds to support a proposed project scope of work using the existing cooperative agreement with NPI. Funds may also be used to supplement ongoing Section 110 projects at an installation through subawards or subcontracts with NPI.
