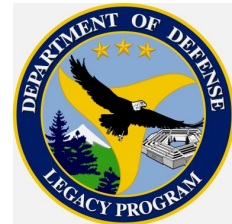

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## DoD Legacy Program NHPA Section 110 Surveys Project Project Goals

- Section 110 projects to identify, evaluate, and nominate historic properties across all Services
- Work cannot be directly related to an ongoing or reasonably foreseeable Section 106 project
- Surveyed to date
  - 49% of land (approx. 10 million acres)
  - 71% of real property assets over 50 years old (approx. 95,000)

Over the next five years (2023-2028) the Department of Defense (DoD) Legacy Resource Management Program will sponsor a series of projects designed to help meet its responsibilities under Section 110 of the National Historic Preservation Act.

**New Department of Defense Partnership**  
 DoD has partnered with the National Preservation Institute (NPI) through a cooperative agreement to work with the cultural resource management leadership in the Military Departments (including their Reserve and National Guard) components to develop high priority projects that will identify and evaluate historic properties. Section 110 projects are strategic, and address long term efforts to identify and evaluate historic properties under an agency's stewardship. In general DoD has surveyed 49% of its land (approximately 10 million acres) and 71% of its real property assets over fifty years of age (approximately 95,000 assets).

**A Substantial Investment**  
 This work represents a substantial investment by the DoD, with \$13.5M allocated to the projects by the Legacy Resource Management Program over five years. Another \$10M of additional capacity is available via contributions from the individual services. During the 2023-2028 cycle NPI will support \$1.2M in Legacy projects.

Funding for this project comes from the Legacy Resource Management Program. NPI is responsible for the implementation of each project, including defining the scope of work, subcontractor selection and oversight, reporting and closure. Installations are responsible for identifying the project, its scope of work, and potential subcontractors. Project execution will be closely coordinated with installation cultural resource management staff.

Installation cultural resource managers will be responsible for consultation with the State Historic Preservation Office (SHPO) and/or Tribal Historic Preservation Office (THPO) regarding the Section 110 survey results. Installations may supplement Legacy Program funds to support a proposed project scope of work using the existing cooperative agreement with NPI. Funds may also be used to supplement ongoing Section 110 projects at an installation through subcontracts or subawards with NPI.

## FAQs: Project Information

- Identification, evaluation, and nomination projects will follow relevant SHPO standards and procedures
- NPI anticipates projects will be a mix of architectural and archaeological survey work and anything else that falls within the context of Section 110 work
- Is there a template for inventory work? No, but states or installations may have a specific format

- NPI will review proposals and talk with contractors as needed to finalize each project's scope of work



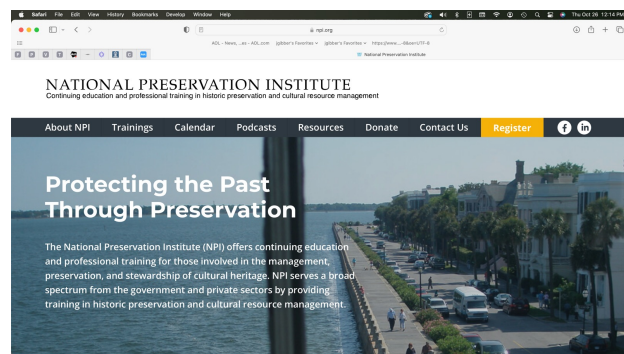
